

Mr. Milton Belardo is a Senior Policy Advisor for the Department of Commerce (DOC), Office of Civil Rights. In this position Mr. Belardo manages a portfolio that includes coordinating Hispanic and Asian Pacific American (APA) employment initiatives, coordinating Limited English Proficiency initiatives, and coordination of EEOC's MD 715 Report for the DOC.
